Tracks may be fully constructed with imported and pre-fabricated materials or using bush resources to achieve the outcome.

The candidate should be prepared to work in challenging bushland environments, sometimes in a remote location, and be prepared to walk equipment/ materials into the work site.

The desired candidate will have a practical and 'hands on' aptitude. They will have come from a landscaping or similar trade background and be experienced with rock retaining, installing treads and repairing drainage.

Note that the work is physically demanding and that applicants should have a high level of health and fitness and to disclose any pre-existing injuries or conditions that

may impact on the job duties. We reserve the right to request a medical to undertake this work.

Base Selection Criteria:

- Ability to work as part of a team.
- Experience with rock pitching and dry walling, retaining, benching, drainage, installation of treads.
