Bushland Restoration Supervisor

This position is field based and involves working in a team environment to successfully deliver bush regeneration projects throughout SE Qld

The position will supervise teams and work in a diversity of natural areas. Activities will include herbicide application, manual weed work and vegetation management.

Selection Criteria:

The successful candidate must be able to successfully demonstrate the following characteristics. A written response is required to address each criteria and where appropriate – provide specific examples to demonstrate your capability:

1. Minimum 24 months experience in a supervisory role within the Bushland Restoration Industry.
2. Strong practical knowledge of restoration practices, bush regeneration, integrated weed control, and site assessment.
3. Good plant identification skills, including weeds and natives in south east Queensland.
4. Physically fit, motivated and capable of working in challenging environments
5. Ability to **lead** project operations and to **drive** teams and contractors to achieve work targets.
5. Knowledge of safety risk processes and responsibilities.

In addition to the above, supervisor applicants shall also address:

Qualifications (essential)

- TAFE/Tertiary qualifications (Cert 3) in the field of bush regeneration, conservation management.
- Current manual Drivers Licence
- ACDC ticket (current)

Desirable (but not required) attributes

- QLD White Card (Construction)
- Senior First Aid
- Chainsaw ticket
- Advanced driving skills (4x4), skid steer ticket, MR licence or tractor operation.
- Experience and confidence in basic maintenance of small engine machinery.
